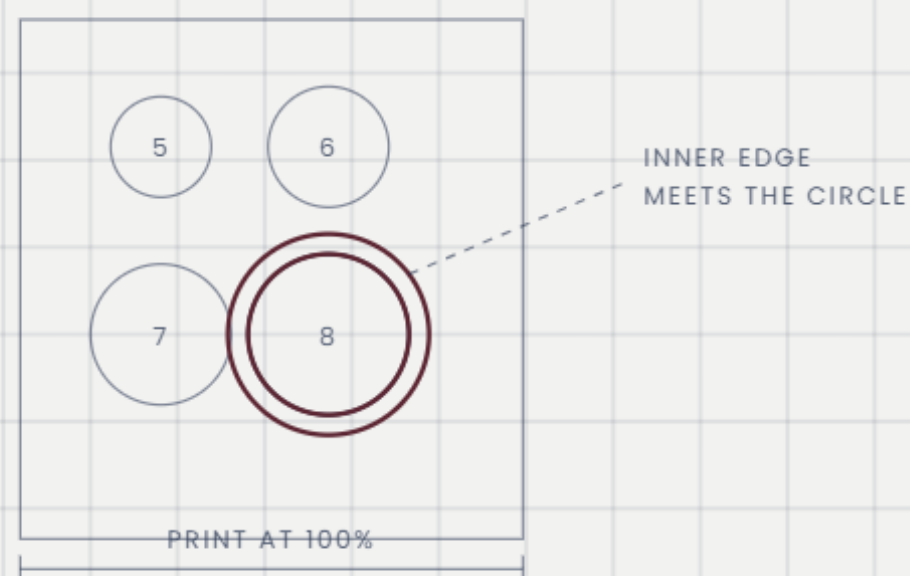

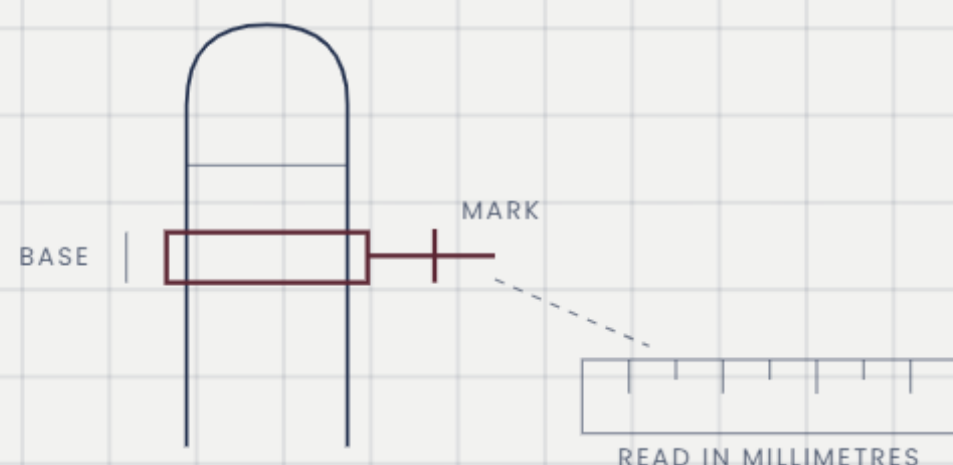

A MEASURE A RING YOU ALREADY OWN PRINTER REQUIRED



- 1 Choose a ring that fits the exact finger you intend to wear the new piece on.
- 2 Download and print the sizing sheet. In the print dialog set **Scale to 100%** — not "fit to page".
- 3 Check the calibration bar on the printed sheet with a ruler before measuring.
- 4 Place the ring over the circles. The circle should sit exactly inside the band, matching its inner edge.

B THE PAPER STRIP NO PRINTER NEEDED



- 1 Cut a thin strip of paper, about 6 inches long and no wider than 5 mm.
- 2 Wrap it snugly around the base of the finger — snug, not tight, and able to pass over the knuckle.
- 3 Mark where the paper overlaps itself.
- 4 Lay the strip flat, measure to the mark in millimetres, and read that circumference against the chart.

Measure at the end of the day, at room temperature. Fingers are smallest in the morning and in the cold.

WIDE BANDS

Where a band is wide and sculptural it covers more of the finger and sits tighter than a thin one. For bands wider than 5 mm, order a half size larger than your standard size.

BETWEEN TWO SIZES

Email the studio before ordering. Answered within the day, weekends included.

IF IT NEEDS ADJUSTING

Have it resized by any jeweler you trust. We reimburse up to \$40 within 90 days of delivery. Eligibility is noted on each product page.
